#### **TUITION REFUND POLICY**

The policy of the Catholic Board of Education regarding tuition refund is as follows:

If a student leaves <u>within 1 - 2 weeks</u> from the start of the term, the parent is entitled to <u>75%</u> <u>refund on tuition</u>.

If a student leaves <u>within 3 - 4 weeks</u> from the start of the term, the parent is entitled to  $\underline{50\%}$  <u>refund on tuition</u>.

If a student leaves after 4 weeks from the start of the term, there is NO REFUND.

\*REGISTRATION, TESTING, CAPITAL DEVELOPMENT AND SPECIAL FEES ARE NON-REFUNDABLE AND NON-TRANSFERABLE.

## RULES AND REGULATIONS – HAIR (September 1, 2025 – June 12, 2026)

The policy handbook of Saint Thomas More School speaks about the hair of our scholars. <u>All</u> students must comply with the following rules and regulations:

## **GIRLS**:

Weave or hair extensions are not allowed. Hair beads or jewels should not be worn. Nail polish is not acceptable. Hair coloring or dye is not appropriate.

\*Braided hair is allowed but must be all natural - no shingles or locked styles!

#### **BOYS**:

A traditional hair cut is most appropriate.

The hair should be short and neatly trimmed.

There should be no afros, locs or braided hair. Additionally, there should be no designs, dyes, tails or buds.

The hair length must be above the collar of the shirt.



## **DISTRIBUTION OF REPORT CARDS**

The distribution of report cards is scheduled for Wednesday, June 18, 2025 from 9:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. for students in Kindergarten – Grade 5.

Parents will not be able to receive the report cards of students with outstanding balances.

## PAYMENT PLAN CONTRACTS

All students from Kindergarten – Grade 5 are <u>strongly encouraged</u> to attend the summer camp program at Saint Thomas More School, especially if low scores were received in Language Arts and Mathematics. <u>It will be held for four (4) weeks from June 23, 2025 - July 18, 2025, Monday – Friday from 8:30 a.m. – 2:00 p.m.</u> Language Arts and Mathematics will be emphasized along with other activities.
