**TUITION REFUND POLICY**

The policy of the Catholic Board of Education regarding tuition refund is as follows:

If a student leaves **within 1 – 2 weeks** from the start of the term, the parent is entitled to **75% refund on tuition.**

If a student leaves **within 3 – 4 weeks** from the start of the term, the parent is entitled to **50% refund on tuition.**

If a student leaves **after 4 weeks** from the start of the term, there is **NO REFUND.**

**\*REGISTRATION, TESTING, CAPITAL DEVELOPMENT AND SPECIAL FEES ARE NON-REFUNDABLE AND NON-TRANSFERABLE.**

**ARRIVAL TO SCHOOL ON TIME**

The first bell rings at **8:15 a.m.** The second bell rings at **8:30 a.m.** which begins our school day. **Tardiness is harmful both to your child’s education and to the class that is being disrupted by your child’s late arrival to school.**



**RULES AND REGULATIONS – HAIR**

The policy handbook of Saint Thomas More School speaks about the hair of our scholars. **All students with hair infractions (boys or girls) will not be allowed in classes.** Students must comply with the following rules and regulations:

**GIRLS:**

- NO** weave or hair extensions
- NO** hair beads or jewels
- NO** nail polish
- NO** hair coloring or dyes
- \*Braided hair is allowed but must be all natural – no shingles or locked styles!**

### **Traditional hair cut**

**Short and neatly trimmed**

**(No afros or braided hair, no locs, designs, faddish paths, dyes, tails or buds)**

**Hair length must be above the collar of the shirt**



## **70<sup>th</sup> ANNIVERSARY T-SHIRTS**

We are excited to celebrate our school's 70<sup>th</sup> Anniversary this academic year. To mark this milestone, commemorative t-shirts are available in the office in limited supply. Additionally, t-shirts can be ordered. ## **SICKNESS PROTOCOLS**

- **Children with a fever, cough, runny nose or congestion are not allowed in school regardless of a possible history of allergies or asthma.**
- A child who is **off sick** for any reason should not return to school until he/she is **free of all symptoms.**
- **When a doctor's letter confirming that a child is fit to return to school has been requested, a copy of this letter must be reviewed by the school nurse before the child can be admitted to school.**
- **Students are encouraged to keep masks in their school bags as they will be needed if the scholar becomes sick during school hours.**
- All medical information is **private and confidential.**



## **HEALTH ASSESSMENT**

It is important for all scholars to be healthy in the school environment. Students should **remain at home** if they are exhibiting any of the following symptoms:

- Fever (Above 100.4° F)
- Sore Throat
- Headache
- Loss of Taste or Smell
- Persistent Cough
- Fatigue/Lethargy
- Shortness of Breath/Difficulty Breathing
- Body Aches/Pain
- Nausea/Vomiting/Diarrhea

## **MEDICATION**

Only prescribed medication will be issued from the school's office. The medication should be sent in a Ziploc bag that is labelled and should have the correct dosage and spoon. The medicine should be collected at the end of the day. Over the counter medication **is not allowed** at school.



## **SECURITY MEASURES (POSSESSIONS)**

Parents are **strongly advised** not to leave valuable possessions in their car at any time. It is important to be **PROACTIVE** and **PREVENT INCIDENCES** of theft occurring on our campus.



## **COLD WEATHER**

Please be advised that **buttoned-down navy-blue jackets or sweaters** should be worn during the cold season. **\*Hooded sweaters and jackets are discouraged at school. Jackets (\$45.00) may be purchased from the school office, subject to size availability.**



## SECURITY MEASURES (CAMPUS PROCEDURES)

- A security officer is posted on campus from **8:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m.**, Monday through Friday.
- Please respect the authority of Mr. James Cepoudi who has been placed at Saint Thomas More School for your child's safety.
- Visitors on the campus of Saint Thomas More School are first asked to **"Sign in"** at the Security booth then proceed to the office.
- Parents who are collecting students ahead of dismissal must report to the school's office to receive an early dismissal slip before proceeding to the classroom to collect the child.
- **Parents who are sending someone to pick up their child before dismissal must send an email to administrators giving authorization for such person to take the child. Authorization must be given before the child is taken from the premises of the school.**



## DEVICES ON CAMPUS

Students are allowed to bring devices on campus (laptops, tablets) once the classroom teacher has given APPROVAL. **Cell phones are not allowed at school. This privilege can be taken away at any time.**
